Each session runs for 1.5 hours from 10.30-12.00 or 1.00-2.30 for groups of up to 30 pupils.

Your booking:

After your booking you will be sent an email confirmation and a contract for the day with a link to our terms and conditions, an invoice will be sent to you the month of the booking.

Due to the historic nature of the site, there is Wheelchair access to ground floor locations only, for instance the Medieval Cloisters, Plantagenet room, Orangery and Victorian Kitchen.

On the day:

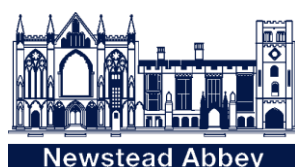
We ask schools to arrive 30 mins before your session to allow time to use the facilities if needed and to ensure a prompt start. There are toilets outside if you wish to use the facilities before your session starts.

Coaches are welcome to bring groups down to the main house, they can then park in the main visitor carpark.

A member of staff will meet you outside the main entrance of the house to welcome you.

Staff to pupil ratios:
